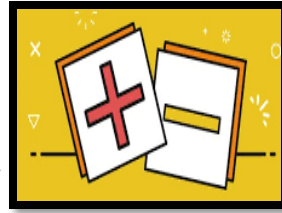


Maths

Writing letters, poetry and diary entries. Re-reading our writing to check it makes sense; using a variety of sentence functions and developing the writer's voice.

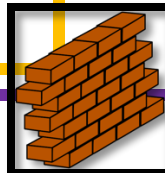

Weekly Spellings

Correct choice and consistent use of present tense and past tense throughout writing.

Formation of nouns using suffixes (-ness, -er):

Introduce how to form nouns by adding -ness (e.g., happiness) and -er (e.g., teacher). Use examples to show how root words change meaning when suffixes are added.
