Maths

This term is maths we will be working on the following areas:

Four operations – addition, subtractions, multiplication and division.

Fractions A: Adding and subtracting fractions with the same, similar multiple, and non-similar denominators.

English

Our English focus this term is based around our text 'A Long Walk to Water' by Linda Park. It is based on a true story, set during the Sudanese civil war during the late 1980's. The children will be producing a range of different writing pieces including a balanced argument focusing on levels of formality and using a range of punctuation..

Religious Education

The title of this terms R.E module is 'Gospel: What would Jesus do?' We will study the features of Gospel texts, suggest meanings of Gospel texts and compare ideas with ways in which Christians interpret biblical texts and relate biblical ideas, teachings of beliefs to the issues of their own community in the world today.

Music

During this unit, titled 'Ame sau vala tara bal', pupils will learn about a variety of styles of Indian music, focussing on bhangra, Bollywood and classical – as well as composing their own rhythmic piece for percussion instruments.

Science - Biology

This terms science is based around the circulatory system and is entitled 'Staying Alive'. The children will look deeper at the functions of the heart and the impact addiction has on the human body.

Computing
