- •'Make your own bird houses




We would also like to put out a request to borrow the following items for the duration of the week beginning 26<sup>th</sup> June whilst we carry out the developments:

## Hot Weather Reminder



Please can you send your child to school every day with their water bottle and a sun hat.

Please can you apply suncream every morning before school, as staff are not able to supply, or apply, sun cream. If your child has particularly sun-sensitive skin and needs an additional application before their lunchbreak, please supply a clearly named bottle of sun cream to be kept in school for your child to apply themselves.
