Maths -

We will continue to build upon the skills we have learned so far this year; applying them to our decimal and percentage module and our area and perimeter module. We learn about equivalent fractions and decimals, as well as how they are used and applied in everyday life.

<u>English</u>

The title of the book we will be reading this term is called 'Sky Song'. It is about two young characters who race across the world, and against the clock, to save their friends and family from the reign of an evil ice queen.

Religious Education-

Linking with the festival of Easter, or learning will focus on incarnation and Jesus as our saviour. The children will explore the idea of what it means to be a saviour and what impact 'the big story' of the Bible has on the world today.

Music

The students will be learning about scales and key signatures; playing more complex tunes on the recorder; learning about scales and arpeggios; composing 4 bar rhythms
