



Squirrel Class: Year 2 – Home Learning Grid – Spring 1

<p><u>1. Reading:</u> Choose a favourite book of yours and write a book review. Tell us what it is about, who the author is, why you like it and who you might recommend it to. Spellings:</u> The j sound spelt as ge and dge at the end of words:</p> <p>badge, edge, bridge, dodge, fudge, age, huge, change, charge, village.</p> <p>Practice these spellings regularly and then use each one to write an interesting <u>question sentence</u>. Science: Everyday Materials</u></p> <p>Look around at home for things that can be bent, squashed, twisted and stretched.
