A Level and Level 3 exam results are to be collected in person between 8.30am and 10.30am on Thursday 17th August from the sixth form study centre. If students have applied for university via UCAS they will have access to the individual decision at 8am via their UCAS hub account. No exam results will be displayed in the UCAS hub.

Current Saint George's Year 11 students can collect their GCSE results from the sixth form study centre on **Thursday 24**th **August between 9am – 10.30am**. **Current students who wish to join our sixth form will also be able to enrol with a member of the sixth form team and take up a confirmed place upon collection of their GCSE results.** Information on how to complete the process will be included within your results envelope.

Please note, to join our sixth form, students **must complete the in-person enrolment process** for a place to be confirmed. A conditional offer does not guarantee a place in the sixth form if enrolment has not taken place.
