The children have had lots of fun on their new Trim Trail this week! It has been lovely to see so many smiley faces.

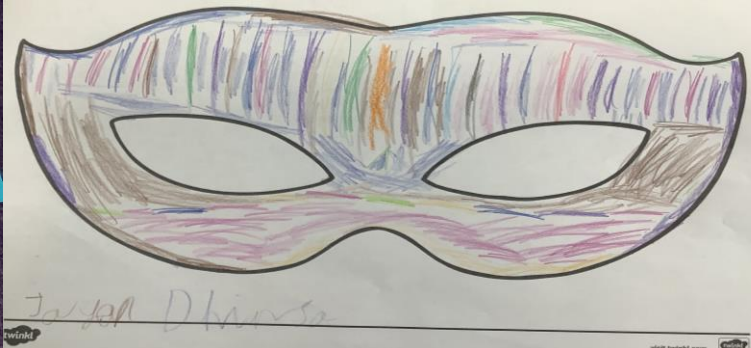


## Windrush Day
