We are writing to inform you of the arrangements for the forthcoming PPE week.

Firstly, we would like to congratulate our Year 11 students on the hard work and commitment to Year 11 so far and for striving to do their best. The overwhelming majority have worked extremely hard during the first term to improve on their last PPE grades. Thank you for your support as parents with this too.

One of our most important strategies for Year 11 is to prepare students to cope effectively with the intensity and demands of a real exam season and this is where our PPE exams come in. The students have a long half term before they begin and we ask that they are encouraged to do some revision at home to prepare for them.

The PPEs will simulate the real exam experience. Students have today been issued with a schedule of exams and we will upload it to our website for your reference. Please note the following;

Session 1 students must report to the exam venue by 8.40am.

- You do not need to attend morning registration, as you will be registered in the venue.
- Session 2 students should report to the exam venue by 11.10am.
- Session 3 report for 1.40pm.
- If you do not have an exam, you must attend 'study hall'. Venues to be confirmed.
- Students do not need to attend morning registration. You will be registered in your exam.
- If you are not in an afternoon exam, you must attend period 6 registration.
- If you miss any exams, they will be scheduled for Tuesday 15th November
- If you have an exam clash, please see Mrs Lane.
